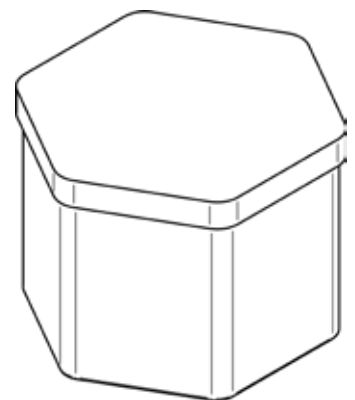

HEXAGONAL TINS .



- Closing mechanism
- ST = slip lid
 - SCH = hinged lid
 - KSD = plastic lid with metal clip
 - PR = premium slip lid

- Lid type
- g = domed lid
 - f = flat lid
 - a = stepped lid for stacking
 - s = special lid shapes – ask about available shapes

- Curls
- IR = inward curl
 - AR = outward curl

- EL = Exclusive Line
 - Available from quantities of just a few thousand
 - Embossing, debossing or relief work on the tin body and the lid
 - Bespoke formats
 - Inward curl on the tin body
 - PL = Perfect Line
 - For large-scale production
 - Outward curl on the tin body and the lid
 - Embossing on the lid possible
